

The Airbus-led consortium including Streamwide has successfully completed the second scenario of the BroadWay project.

STREAMWIDE, a leading technology software provider for critical communications and operations, was a key player and especially developed the interoperability hub server in the recent successful field test of the EU-funded BroadWay Project, marking a new milestone in pan-European critical crossborder communications tasked with improving public safety and security.

The field test, carried out by an Airbus-led consortium, involved over seventy officers from different national emergency services and featured a realistically-staged high-speed chase of a drug-smuggling vehicle in Kerkrade, a Dutch municipality located near the Netherlands' borders with Belgium and Germany. Kerkrade was chosen as an ideal location for testing the consortium's capability to facilitate cross-border communications with a view to enhancing public safety, security and disaster relief.

The Airbus consortium was responsible for establishing an entire field communications network to test the effectiveness and efficiency of national emergency services and public safety teams' communications when on fast-moving missions in a crossborder environment. The consortium's solution allows for instantaneous and automatic re-selection of networks when public safety and security operatives are on critical missions in a roaming situation and need to have total confidence in their communication devices and channels.

The field test enabled STREAMWIDE to successfully demonstrate the technical features of its **team on mission (TOM)** mission critical communications solution which allows real-time information sharing between emergency, security and rescue services from different countries when deployed in a border region.

Besides STREAMWIDE (France), the Airbus-led consortium included Telekom Slovenia (Slovenia); VodafoneZiggo (Netherlands); BICS (Belgium); Latvia Mobile Telecom (LMT) (Latvia); Pentatech (Poland); and Umlaut (Germany).

Following the successful completion of this second BroadWay project trial - the first being a forest fire situation in Ljubljana, Slovenia - the Airbus consortium now closes the BroadWay project*. The next step in the EU-funded project, defined as BroadNet, will represent the final procurement and live use of the communications solution and is currently under preparation.

* The BroadWay project is funded by the EU Commission and aims at improving operational mobility for public safety responders across Europe by enabling national communications networks to act as one without the restrictions of geopolitical boundaries. BroadWay is led by the Public Safety Communications Europe Forum, which gathers representatives of public safety user organizations, industry and research and consists in a Pre-Commercial Procurement approach. The project includes decision makers from 11 ministries and agencies responsible

for providing public safety communication capabilities in their respective countries (Belgium, France, Czech Republic, Estonia, Finland, Greece, Italy, Ireland, The Netherlands, Romania and Spain).
