Protecting field agents with Team on the run: A LWP/DATI solution for safety

Context: Safeguard municipal agents against field risks

The City of Paris has committed to a proactive approach to **occupational risk prevention** to better protect its field agents. Among the most sensitive environments are **municipal cemeteries**, where agents work under potentially hazardous conditions: open cavities, uneven ground, occasional isolation. A simple incident can quickly escalate.

In compliance with regulations on the **protection of isolated workers (LWP/DATI)**, the City of Paris sought a reliable, responsive, and easy-to-deploy solution to ensure the safety of its teams in these specific environments.





An all-in-one solution for agent safety

To meet this need, **the City of Paris** deployed **Team on the run (TOTR)**, a secure and mobile platform for alert management and isolated agent protection. This solution enables automatic incident detection, precise agent geolocation, and smooth coordination of emergency responses in critical situations.

A comprehensive system to protect field or isolated agents:

• **Detect falls or fainting automatically**, using integrated sensors and verticality loss monitoring.

• Activate manual alerts via an emergency button to send calls and messages in case of danger.

• Locate agents in real time to pinpoint the exact location of those in distress.

• Use push-to-talk (PTT) calls and ambient listening, allowing the control center to quickly assess the situation.

• Enable rapid and targeted interventions by identifying the nearest agent and efficiently coordinating rescue efforts.



Observed results

• **Reduce response times** in case of incidents, with faster and localized assistance.

• **Improve coordination** between field teams and safety supervisors.

• **Ensure regulatory compliance** for the protection of isolated workers (LWP/DATI).

• Enhance the sense of security and confidence among municipal agents.

• Strengthen the image of the City of Paris as a leader in risk prevention and modernization of working conditions.
